11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; creating the
12 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police License
13 Plate Revolving Fund; allowing for expenditures of
14 funds; providing purposes for expenditures; amending
15 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as amended by Section
16 1, Chapter 204, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2012,
17 Section 1135.2), which relates to special license
18 plates; modifying design of World War II Veteran
19 plate; combining certain license plates for widows of
20 veterans and expanding eligibility; creating Legion
21 of Merit Medal Recipient plate; providing for
22 eligibility and design; amending 47 O.S. 2011,
23 Section 1135.3, as amended by Section 1 of Enrolled
24 House Bill No. 1351 of the 1st Session of the 54th
Oklahoma Legislature; which relates to special
license plates; modifying eligibility for Civil

Gamma Rho license plates; modifying eligibility for
BMW Car Club of America plates and providing for
reauthorization; creating Oklahomans for the Arts
license plate; providing for design; creating
Oklahoma City Barons license plate; providing for

creating Tulsa Shock license plate; providing for
design; creating Tulsa Oilers license plate;

6 plate; providing for design; amending 47 O.S. 2011,
7 Section 1135.5, as amended by Section 2 of Enrolled
8 House Bill No. 1351 of the 1st Session of the 54th
9 Oklahoma Legislature; which relates to special
10 license plates; creating Chiefs of Police license
11 plate; providing for design; providing for deposit of
12 portion of fee in certain fund; creating Crossings
13 Christian School license plate; providing for design;
14 providing for licensing agreement; providing for
15 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.23 of Title 47, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by paragraph
21 51 of subsection B of Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
22 Statutes for Chiefs of Police license plates shall be deposited to
23 the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police License Plate Revolving
24 Fund created in subsection B of this section.

25 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
26 fund for the State Department of Public Safety to be designated the
27 "Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police License Plate Revolving
28 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
29 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
30 State Department of Public Safety pursuant to subsection A of this

1 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
2 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State
3 Department of Public Safety to assist with funding for training and
4 education for law enforcement agencies throughout the state.
5 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
6 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
7 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
8 approval and payment.

9 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
10 amended by Section 1, Chapter 204, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2012,
11 Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

12 Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
13 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
14 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
15 provided by this section.

16 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
17 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
18 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
19 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
20 registered for the current year.

21 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
22 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
23 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
24 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain

1 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
2 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
3 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
4 amateur radio operator license plates.

5 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
6 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
7 applications for special license plates authorized under this
8 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
9 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
10 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
11 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
12 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
13 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
14 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
15 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
16 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

17 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
18 follows:

19 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
21 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
22 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
23 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
24 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having

1 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
2 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
3 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
4 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
5 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
6 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
7 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
8 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
9 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

10 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
12 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
13 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
14 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

15 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
17 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
18 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
19 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

20 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
21 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
22 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
23 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
24 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member

1 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
2 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
3 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
4 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or
5 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
6 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
7 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
8 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

9 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
10 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
11 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
12 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
13 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
14 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

15 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
17 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
18 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
19 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
20 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
21 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
22 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
23 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
24 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in

1 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
2 of one (1) ton or less;

3 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
5 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
6 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
7 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
8 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
9 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
10 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
11 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
12 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
13 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
14 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
17 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
18 the United States as being:

- 19 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
20 7, 1941,
21 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
22 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
23 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
24 exceed three (3) miles, and

1 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
2 States Armed Forces.

3 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
4 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
5 less;

6 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
7 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
8 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
9 States as being:

10 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
11 of 1945,

12 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
13 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and

14 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
15 States Armed Forces.

16 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
17 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

18 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
19 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
20 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
21 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
22 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
23 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
24 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the

1 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
2 registration after the initial issue;

3 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
5 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
6 the United States as being:

7 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
8 1944,

9 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
10 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
11 participation cannot be verified by the United States
12 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
13 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
14 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
15 the person applying for the license plate, and

16 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
17 States Armed Forces.

18 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
19 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

20 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
22 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
23 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
24 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action

1 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
2 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
3 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
4 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
5 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
6 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
7 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
8 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
9 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

10 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
12 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
13 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
14 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
15 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
16 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
17 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
18 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
19 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
20 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
21 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

22 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
24 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the

1 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
2 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
3 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
4 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

5 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
7 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
8 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
12 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
13 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
14 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
15 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
16 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
17 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
18 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
19 education police department by either an identification card or
20 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
21 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
22 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
23 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
24 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
2 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
3 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
4 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

5 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
7 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
8 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
9 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
10 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
11 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
12 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
13 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

14 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
15 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
16 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
17 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Force Corps,
18 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
19 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
20 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
21 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
22 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
23 "WORLD WAR II";

24

1 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
3 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
4 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
5 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
6 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
7 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
8 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
9 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

10 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
11 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
12 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
13 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
14 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
15 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
16 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
17 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
18 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

19 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
21 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
22 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
23 be produced upon application;

1 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
3 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
4 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
5 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
6 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
7 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
8 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
9 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
10 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
11 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
12 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
13 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
14 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

15 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
16 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
17 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
18 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
19 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
20 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
21 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

22 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
23 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
24 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and

1 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
2 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
3 of one (1) ton or less;

4 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
6 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
7 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
8 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
10 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
11 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
12 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

13 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
15 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
16 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
17 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
18 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

19 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
20 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
21 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
22 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
23 the Ninety-Nines;

24

1 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
2 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
3 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
4 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
5 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
6 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
7 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
8 less;

9 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
11 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
12 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
13 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
14 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
17 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
18 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
19 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

20 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
22 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
23 United States Secretary of Defense;
24

1 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
4 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
5 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
6 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
9 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
10 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
11 district number;

12 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
14 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
15 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
16 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
17 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
18 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
19 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
20 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
21 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
22 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
23 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
24 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
2 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
3 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
4 annulment, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
5 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
6 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
7 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
8 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
9 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
10 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

11 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
12 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
13 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
14 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
15 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
16 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
17 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
18 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
19 the Tax Commission;

20 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
21 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
22 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
23 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
24 designed in consultation with the Association;

1 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
3 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
4 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
5 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
6 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
7 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
8 Academy;

9 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
11 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
12 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
13 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
14 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
15 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
16 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
17 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
18 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
19 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
20 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
21 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
22 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
23 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
24 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee

1 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
2 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
3 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
4 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
5 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
6 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any

18 45. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
20 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one
21 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this
22 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system
23 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included
24 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a

1 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a
2 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; and

3 46. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
5 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
6 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
7 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
8 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.
9 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
10 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one

12 47. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting

17 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient
18 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one

18 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
19 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
20 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
21 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
22 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
23 issued on a staggered system.

1 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
14 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
15 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
16 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
17 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
18 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
19 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
20 removed from the vehicle.

21 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
22 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
23 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
24 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications

1 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
2 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
3 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
4 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
5 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
6 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

7 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as

8 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for

10 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
11 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
13 contain the Shriner's emblem;

14 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
15 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
16 ballooning in this state;

17 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
19 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
20 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
21 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
22 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
23 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
24 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
2 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

3 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
5 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
6 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
8 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
9 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
10 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
11 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
12 Columbus emblem;

13 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
14 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
15 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

17 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying
19 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
20 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed
21 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

22 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
24 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in

1 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
2 consultation with Kiwanis International;

3 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
5 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified

6 ~~Club of America.~~ The plates shall be issued to any person in any
7 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
8 as for personalized license plates. The license plate shall be
9 designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of the BMW Car
10 Club of America. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this
11 section, the BMW Car Club of America License Plate is hereby
12 reauthorized effective November 1, 2013; and

13 57. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem
15 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden
16 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

18 58. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
20 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.
21 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the
22 Arts;

23 59. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

1 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The
3 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
4 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

5 60. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
7 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in
8 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

9 61. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed
10 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
11 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
12 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

13 62. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
14 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
15 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
16 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

17 63. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
19 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in
20 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

21 64. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall
22 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
23 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be
24

1 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School
2 District;

3 65. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such
4 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
5 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National
7 Alumni Association;

8 66. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and
10 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current
11 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
12 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

13 67. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
14 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original
16 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
17 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center; and

18 68. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
19 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
20 Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
21 Tulsa 66ers Organization.

22 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
23 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by
24 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise

1 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:
2 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be
3 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
4 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
5 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the
6 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
7 Section 1104 of this title.

8 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
9 amended by Section 2 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1351 of the 1st
10 Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
11 follows:

12 Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
13 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
14 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
15 financial assistance as provided by this section.

16 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
17 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
18 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
19 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
20 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

21 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
22 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
23 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
24 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain

1 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
2 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
3 issued on a staggered system.

4 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
5 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
6 applications for special license plates authorized under this
7 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
8 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
9 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
10 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
11 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
12 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
13 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
14 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
15 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

16 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
17 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
18 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
19 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
20 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
21 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
22 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
23 removed from the vehicle.

24

1 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
2 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
3 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
4 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
5 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
6 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
7 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
8 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
9 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

10 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
11 follows:

12 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
15 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
16 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

17 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
18 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
19 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
20 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
21 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
22 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
23 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
24 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination

1 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
2 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
3 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
4 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
5 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
6 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
7 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
8 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

9 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
10 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
11 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
12 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
13 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
14 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
15 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
16 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
17 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
18 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
19 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
20 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
21 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
22 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
23 of the fire department.

24

1 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
2 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
3 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
4 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
5 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
6 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
7 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for
8 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
9 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
10 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
11 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
12 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
13 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

14 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
15 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
16 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
17 Living Memorial;

18 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
20 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
21 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
22 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
23 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
24 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may

1 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
2 plates.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
5 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
8 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
9 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
10 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the prevention of child abuse.

12 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

14 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
15 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
16 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
17 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
18 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
19 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
20 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
21 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
22 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
23 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
24 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not

1 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
2 issued;

3 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
5 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
7 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

8 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
10 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
11 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
12 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
13 Oklahoma;

14 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
16 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
17 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
18 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
19 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
20 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
23 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
24 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
2 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
3 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
4 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
5 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician
6 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
7 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
10 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
11 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
12 Revolving Fund;

13 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
16 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
17 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
19 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
20 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
21 provide services to crime victims;

22 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The

1 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
3 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
4 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
5 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

6 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
7 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
8 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
10 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
11 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
12 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
13 Section 1104.4 of this title;

14 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
15 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
16 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
17 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
18 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
19 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
20 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
21 Section 1104.3 of this title;

22 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
24 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
3 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
5 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
6 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
9 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
10 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
12 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
13 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
14 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
15 follows:

- 16 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
17 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 18 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
19 Education Revolving Fund,
- 20 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
21 Career Technology Fund, and
- 22 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
23 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
24

1 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes.

3 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
4 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
5 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
6 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
7 paragraph;

8 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
9 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
10 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
11 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
12 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
13 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
14 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
15 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
16 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
17 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
20 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
21 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
22 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
23 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
24

1 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
2 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

3 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
6 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
7 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
8 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
9 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
10 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
11 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
12 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
13 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
14 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

15 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
17 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
18 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
19 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
20 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
22 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
23 of this title;

24

1 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
5 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
7 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
8 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

9 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
10 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
11 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
12 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
13 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
14 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
15 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
16 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
17 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
18 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
19 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
20 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
21 specifically for created families;

22 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
23 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
24 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of

1 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
2 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
3 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
4 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
5 this title;

6 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
9 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
12 Section 1104.7 of this title;

13 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
14 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
15 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
17 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
19 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
20 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
21 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
22 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
23 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
24 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

1 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
4 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
5 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
6 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
7 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
8 Section 1104.8 of this title;

9 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
10 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
12 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
13 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
14 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
15 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
16 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
17 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
18 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
19 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
20 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
21 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
22 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;

24

1 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
4 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
5 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
6 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
7 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
8 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
9 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
10 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
15 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
16 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

17 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
19 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
20 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
21 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
22 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
23 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
24 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

1 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
4 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
6 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
7 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
8 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the

14 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
15 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
16 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
17 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
18 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
19 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

20 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
21 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
22 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
23 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
24 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on

1 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
2 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
3 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
5 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
9 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
10 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
11 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
12 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
13 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
14 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
15 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
16 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
17 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
18 plate issued;

19 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall
20 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
21 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
22 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
23 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
24

1 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
2 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

3 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
6 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
7 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
8 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
9 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
11 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

12 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
14 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
15 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
16 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
17 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
18 title;

19 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
20 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
21 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
22 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
24 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be

1 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
2 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

3 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
6 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
7 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
8 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
9 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
10 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
11 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
12 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
14 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
15 each license plate issued;

16 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
17 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
18 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization
19 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
20 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
21 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
22 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in
23 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
24 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of

1 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall
2 be designed in consultation with Folds of Honor Incorporated and
3 shall contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which
4 includes the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate.
5 The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing
6 agreement with Folds of Honor Incorporated for any licensing fees
7 which may be required in order to use the Folds of Honor
8 Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
9 for a payment to Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars
10 (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

11 41. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
14 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
15 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
16 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
17 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
18 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
19 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
20 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
21 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in
22 order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
23 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers

1 Association of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
2 license plate;

3 42. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
5 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.
6 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
7 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
8 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
9 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this
10 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
11 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
12 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 43. Buffalo Soldier License Plate - such plates shall be issued
14 to any person wishing to honor and celebrate the history and
15 contribution of the Buffalo Soldiers. The license plates shall be
16 designed in consultation with the Lawton-Fort Sill Chapter of the
17 Buffalo Soldiers 9th and 10th (Horse) Cavalry Association. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Buffalo Soldier License Plate Revolving Fund
20 created in Section 1104.16 of this title;

21 44. Prevent Blindness Oklahoma License Plate - such plates
22 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
23 for vision screening of school age children in this state. The
24 license plates shall be designed in consultation with Prevent

1 Blindness Oklahoma. As provided in this section, an amount of the
2 fee collected shall be deposited in the Prevent Blindness Oklahoma
3 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.17 of this
4 title;

5 45. Oklahoma State Capitol Restoration License Plate - such
6 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for restoration of the Oklahoma State Capitol
8 building. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
9 the Friends of the Capitol corporation, created pursuant to Section
10 15.4 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the State Capitol
11 Preservation Commission created pursuant to Section 4102 of Title 74
12 of the Oklahoma Statutes. As provided in this section, an amount of
13 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Friends of the
14 Capitol License Plate Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.18
15 of this title;

16 46. Eastern Red Cedar Tree License Plates - such plates shall
17 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
18 Commission and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
19 for the removal of Eastern Red Cedar trees from lands in the state
20 and to develop marketable uses for the harvested trees. The license
21 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Eastern Red Cedar
22 Registry Board. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected
23 shall be deposited in the Eastern Red Cedar Revolving Fund created
24 in Section 18-407 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The money

1 shall be designated for and may only be expended for the purposes as
2 set forth in the Eastern Red Cedar Registry Board Act;

3 47. Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate - such plates
4 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
5 for the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer
6 Research Fund. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
7 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
8 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
9 University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund.
10 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
11 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
12 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

13 48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be
14 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
15 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates
16 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
17 Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
18 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research
19 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this
20 title;

21 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates
22 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
23 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The
24 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

1 Hospice and Palliative Care Association. As provided in this
2 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
3 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in
4 Section 1104.21 of this title;

5 50. Juvenile Diabetes Research License Plate - such plates
6 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
7 for the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
8 Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
9 with the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
10 Foundation. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
11 collected shall be deposited in the Juvenile Diabetes Research
12 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.22 of this
13 title;

14 51. Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate - such plates
15 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
16 for the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate
20 Revolving Fund created in Section 3 of ~~this act~~ Enrolled House Bill
21 No. 1351 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature; and

22 52. Lupus Awareness and Education License Plate - such plates
23 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
24 for the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be

1 designed in consultation with the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. As
2 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
3 deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created
4 in Section 4 of ~~this act~~ Enrolled House Bill No. 1351 of the 1st
5 Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature;

6 53. Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be
7 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
8 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police. The license plates shall
9 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
10 of Police. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
11 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
12 of Police License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1 of this
13 act; and

14 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
16 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City.
17 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
18 administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission
19 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with
20 Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be
21 required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing
22 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian
23 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
24 plate issued.

1 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
2 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
3 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
4 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

5 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
6 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
7 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
8 license plate;

9 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
10 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
11 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
12 and

13 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
14 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

15 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
